1. TEXTBOOKS

The Library classifies textbooks either by jurisdiction (**GO13, GA2 etc.**) or according to subject area, examples of which include **Comparative Law (SB)**, **Public International Law (SG)** and **Private International Law/Conflict of Laws (SH)**. Textbooks on **Common Law** topics for **Common Law** jurisdictions (Australia, Canada, New Zealand, UK, USA) are shelved in a special section (**SJ**)

There may be further copies of **Short Loan** textbooks in the **Main Collections** on the lower floors. Please check the Catalogue for alternative locations.
