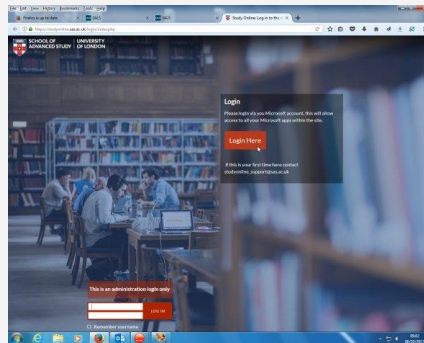

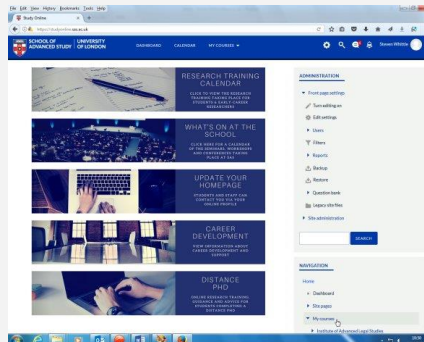

VLE Login:

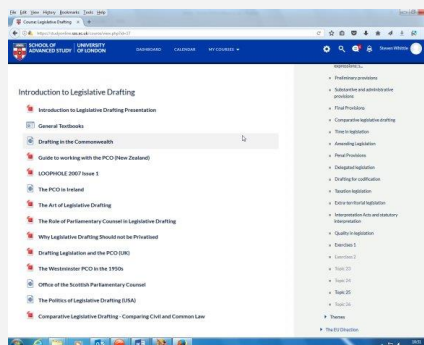
Using the "Login Here" option, enter your SAS email account username (eg `firstname.familyname@postgrad.sas.ac.uk`) as the Study Online username and the password from your SAS email account as the Study Online password.



Links to your IALS courses will display on the welcome screen.



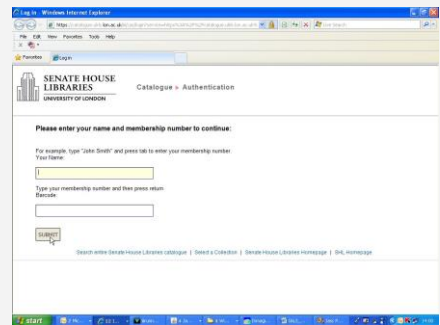
Your course welcome screen will be displayed, showing session topics and the associated reading materials.



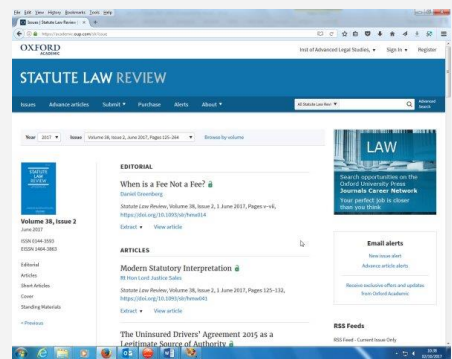
Online Journal Articles:

Some materials in the VLE are provided by IALS Library subscriptions to e-resources.

When prompted, use your current SAS ID card to login to the resource. Enter your family name and the barcode number from your SAS ID card (normally 10 digits)



You should then have access to the full text articles recommended by your course tutor.



Often these are articles in PDF format which you can print or save.
