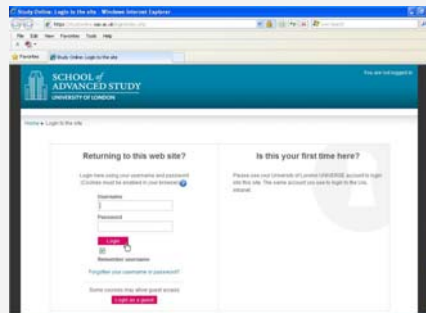

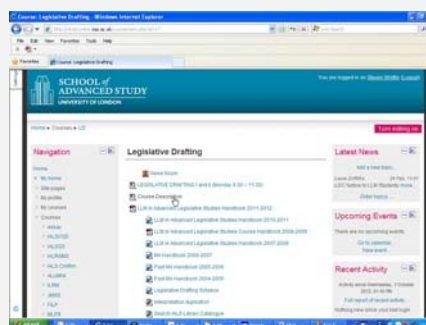
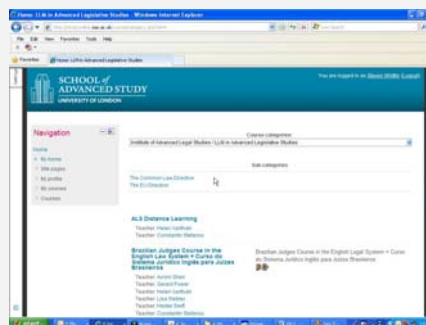

Enter your SAS universe account username (eg firstname.familyname) as the Study Online username and your SAS universe or email account password as the Study Online password.



Links to your IALS courses will display on the left of the welcome screen.

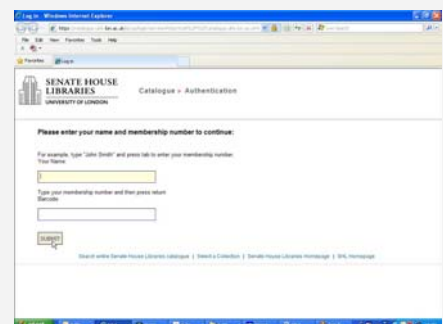


Online Journal Articles:

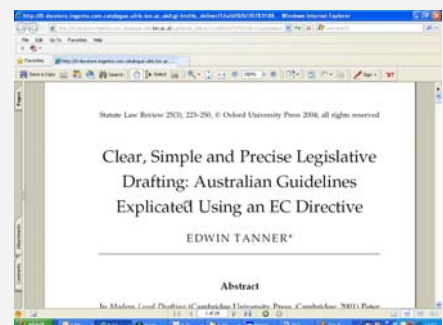


Some materials in the VLE are provided by IALS Library subscriptions to e-resources.

When prompted, use your current SASCARD to login to the resource. Enter your family name and the barcode from the back of your SASCARD (normally 10 digits beginning 031... or 019...)



You should then have access to the full text articles recommended by your course tutor.



Often these are articles in PDF format which you can print or save.
