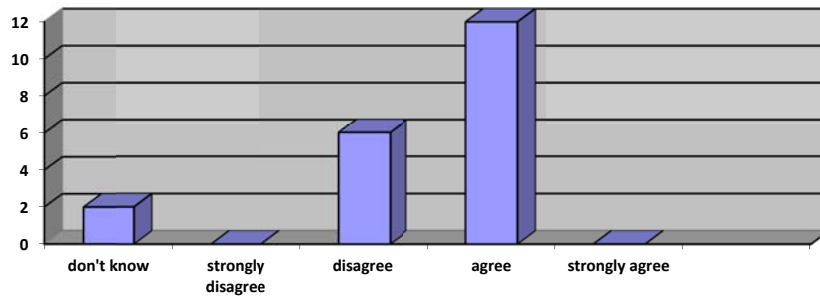
The visit to the Office of Parliamentary Counsel is a worthwhile activity



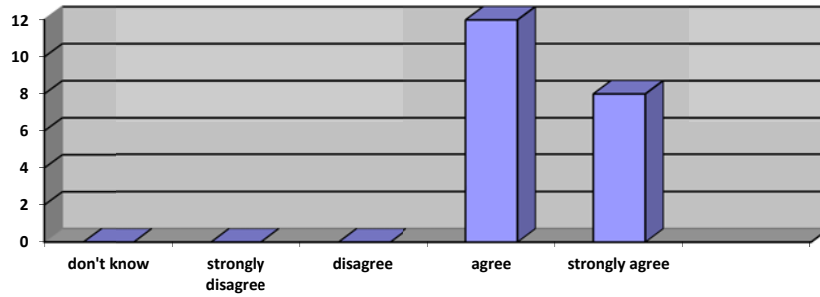
The exercise session by the Office of Parliamentary Counsel is a worthwhile activity



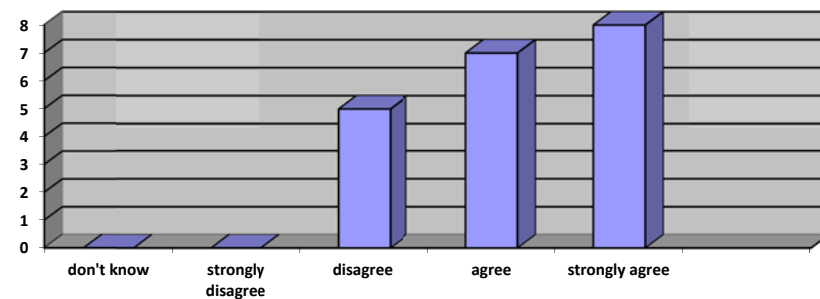

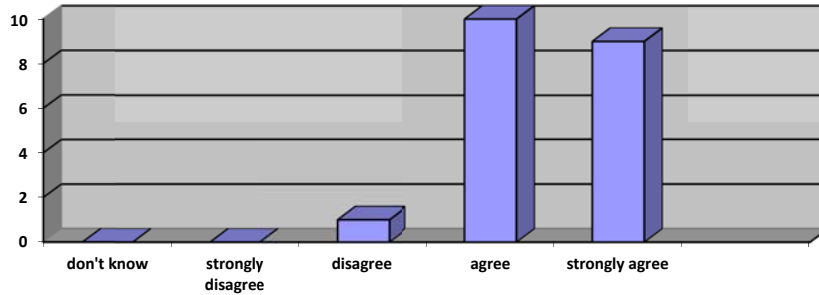
